- (iii) Only to a holder of a Class B beer, wine and liquor (on-sale) license that is issued for use on the premises of a restaurant located in Baltimore City or in Dorchester County.
 - (2) A holder of a Class 7 micro-brewery license:
 - (i) May brew and bottle malt beverages at a single location; and
- $% \left(ii\right) =0$ (ii) May not brew more than 10,000 barrels of malt beverage each calendar year.
- (3) (i) {The} IN DORCHESTER COUNTY, THE on-sale privilege authorizes the holder to sell at retail beer brewed under this license to customers for consumption on the licensed premises.
- (ii) The off-sale privilege authorizes the holder to sell and deliver beer brewed under this license to:
- 1. Any wholesaler licensed under this article to sell beer in this State; or
- 2. Any person who is located in a state other than Maryland who is authorized under the laws of that state to receive brewed beverages.
- (4) (I) (III) IN BALTIMORE CITY ONLY, THE HOLDER IS AUTHORIZED TO SELL AT RETAIL BEER BREWED UNDER THIS LICENSE TO CUSTOMERS FOR CONSUMPTION:
 - 1. ON THE LICENSED PREMISES; AND
- 2. OFF THE LICENSED PREMISES IN SEALED REFILLABLE CONTAINERS THAT ARE SEALED BY THE MICRO-BREWERY LICENSEE AT THE TIME OF EACH REFILL.
- (II) THE REFILLABLE CONTAINERS MAY BE RETURNED AND AT THE TIME OF REFILL SHALL BE SEALED BY THE MICRO BREWERY LICENSEE.
- (III) THE OFF SALE PRIVILEGE ALSO AUTHORIZES THE HOLDER TO SELL AND DELIVER BEER BREWED UNDER THIS LICENSE TO:
- 1. ANY RETAIL LICENSEE WHO IS LICENSED UNDER THIS ARTICLE TO SELL BEER IN THIS STATE; OR
- 2. ANY PERSON WHO IS LOCATED IN A STATE OTHER THAN MARYLAND WHO IS AUTHORIZED UNDER THE LAWS OF THAT STATE TO RECEIVE BREWED BEVERAGES.
 - $\{(4)\}$ (5) A holder of a Class 7 micro-brewery license:
- (i) May not own, operate or be affiliated with any other manufacturer of beer; and
