# Refusal of Psychiatric Medication - Administrative Clinical Review Panel

FOR the purpose of providing the circumstances under which involuntarily admitted psychiatric patients may be medicated against their will; defining certain terms; providing for the evaluation of this Act by a certain time; and generally relating to the administration of psychiatric medication.

FOR the purpose of providing the circumstances under which psychiatric medication may be administered to an individual who is hospitalized involuntarily or committed for treatment by order of a court when the individual refuses medication; authorizing a clinical review panel to approve the administration of certain medication to certain individuals under certain circumstances; providing for the membership of a clinical review panel; providing for notice to and an opportunity to be heard by an individual before a clinical review panel; requiring a clinical review panel to make certain determinations before it may approve the administration of medication to an individual who refuses medication; providing for a right to appeal from a certain decision by a clinical review panel; providing for the renewal of an approval by a clinical review panel; providing certain persons certain immunity under certain circumstances; defining certain terms; providing for the evaluation of this Act by a certain time; and generally relating to the administration of psychiatric medication.
