A MEMBER OF A CLINICAL REVIEW PANEL UNDER § 10-708 OF THE HEALTH - GENERAL ARTICLE WHO ACTS IN GOOD FAITH AND WITHIN THE PANEL'S DUTIES IS IMMUNE FROM CIVIL LIABILITY AS A RESULT OF THOSE ACTS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991. This Act shall remain effective for a period of 2 years and at the end of January 1, 1993, an evaluation report on this Act recommending reestablishment or termination of this Act shall be prepared by the Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene in consultation with the Maryland Hospital Association, the State ~~Designated Protection~~ Advocacy Agency designated protection advocacy agency, and other affected parties, and shall be submitted to the Governor and the General Assembly.

CHAPTER 386

(House Bill 595)

AN ACT concerning

Cemeteries - Perpetual Care

FOR the purpose of requiring persons selling cemetery lots or burial rights with perpetual care to file a certain report with and pay a certain fee to the Secretary of State, to keep certain records, and to open their records to certain persons; providing that the Secretary of State may adopt certain regulations; providing that the Secretary of State may make a referral to the Attorney General or the State's Attorney; providing that the Attorney General may institute a civil action for equitable relief or a certain fine or both; and generally relating to cemeteries and perpetual care.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
