- (B) IN THE CASE OF AN INDIVIDUAL PERFORMING DESERT SHIELD SERVICE, OR THE SPOUSE OF SUCH AN INDIVIDUAL, THE PERIOD DURING WHICH THE INDIVIDUAL PERFORMS THAT SERVICE AND THE NEXT 60 DAYS THEREAFTER SHALL BE DISREGARDED FOR THE PURPOSES SET FORTH IN § 2 111 OF THIS TITLE:
- (C) IF THE AREA COVERED BY THE DESERT SHIELD OPERATION IS DESIGNATED A COMBAT ZONE AS PROVIDED IN § 7508 OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE, THEN THE PROVISIONS OF § 7508 SHALL BE APPLICABLE FOR THE PURPOSES LISTED IN SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted.
