"Vehicle" means any device in, on, or by which any individual or property is or might be transported or towed on a highway.

21-1116.

- (a) Except as provided in § 21–1211 of this article, on any highway or on any private property that is used by the public in general, a person may not drive a vehicle in a race or speed contest, whether or not on a wager or for a prize or reward.
- (b) Except as provided in § 21-1211 of this article, a person may not participate as a timekeeper or flagman in any race or speed contest specified in subsection (a) of this section.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991.

Mortgage Servicers - Regulation
