## **CHAPTER 390**

(House Bill 635)

AN ACT concerning

## Domestic Violence - Protective Order - Elderly and Vulnerable Adults

FOR the purpose of extending certain domestic violence laws to specifically include alleged abuse of a vulnerable adult; authorizing certain individuals to file a certain petition with the court to obtain a protective order for alleged abuse of a vulnerable adult; requiring a local department of social services to investigate certain alleged abuse of a vulnerable adult in a certain manner; authorizing the court to issue certain orders to protect a vulnerable adult; altering a certain definition; defining certain terms; and generally relating to alleged abuse of certain vulnerable adults.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article - Family Law

4-501.

- (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.
- (b) (1) "Abuse" means any of the following acts committed by a household member against another household member:
  - (i) an act that causes serious bodily harm;
- (ii) an act that places another in fear of imminent serious bodily harm; [or]
  - (iii) abuse of a child, as defined in Title 5, Subtitle 7 of this article; OR
  - (IV) ABUSE OF A VULNERABLE ADULT.
- (2) Nothing in this subtitle shall be construed to prohibit reasonable corporal punishment, in light of the age and condition of the child, from being performed by a parent or stepparent of the child.
  - (c) "Court" means the District Court or a circuit court in this State.
