

C. Forward the fingerprints through the Maryland Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services for transmittal to the Federal Bureau of Investigation for a national criminal history records check. Applicants for license renewal may be subject to these provisions.

(v) 1. IN FREDERICK COUNTY, THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS SHALL:

A. OBTAIN POLICE RECORDS OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE APPLICANTS FROM THE MARYLAND STATE POLICE CRIMINAL JUSTICE INFORMATION SYSTEM CENTRAL REPOSITORY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES;

B. REQUIRE APPLICANTS FOR ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSES IN THE COUNTY TO BE FINGERPRINTED; AND

C. FORWARD THE FINGERPRINTS THROUGH THE MARYLAND DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES FOR TRANSMITTAL TO THE FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION FOR A NATIONAL CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORDS CHECK.

2. APPLICANTS FOR LICENSE RENEWAL MAY NOT BE SUBJECT TO THESE PROVISIONS.

(VI) The respective board shall destroy the records obtained under [subparagraph (ii) or subparagraph (iv)] SUBPARAGRAPHS (II), (IV), AND (V) of this paragraph upon completion of its necessary use of the records;

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991.

AN ACT concerning

Labor and Employment

FOR the purpose of adding a new article to the Annotated Code of Maryland, to be designated and known as the "Labor and Employment Article", to revise, restate, and recodify the laws of the State relating and pertaining to: the Division of Labor and Industry in the Department of Licensing and Regulation; certain employment matters, including employment of minors, equal pay for equal work, minimum wages, wages for overtime, wage payment and collection, payment of commissions for wholesale sales representatives, rights of applicants for employment concerning
