- (III) 1. THERE SHALL BE ONLY 1 MAJOR PRIZE IN A SINGLE-DRAWING RAFFLE.
- 2. DURING A YEAR, AN ORGANIZATION MAY NOT HOLD MORE THAN:
- A. 1 SINGLE-DRAWING RAFFLE IN WHICH THE MAJOR PRIZE IS VALUED AT \$500 \$2,500 OR MORE; OR
- <u>B.</u> <u>5 SINGLE-DRAWING RAFFLES IN WHICH THE</u> MAJOR PRIZE IS VALUED AT LESS THAN \$2,500.
 - (IV) 4. AN ORGANIZATION MAY NOT HOLD:
- \overline{A} . 1. MORE THAN 30 WEEKLY DRAWINGS IN A MULTI-DRAWING RAFFLE;
- B: 2. MORE THAN 2 MULTI-DRAWING RAFFLES DURING A YEAR;
- \leftarrow 3. A MULTI-DRAWING RAFFLE IN WHICH THE MAJOR PRIZE IS VALUED AT OVER \$1,100.
- (V) Before any carnival, bazaar, raffle or game may be operated such group shall first obtain a permit from the County Commissioners of Carroll County, which permit shall provide that the carnival, bazaar, raffle or game shall be managed and operated only by members of the group and the permit may not be transferable.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991.

CHAPTER 401

(House Bill 783)

AN ACT concerning

Maryland Pharmacy Assistance Program - Copayment

FOR the purpose of altering the Maryland Pharmacy Assistance Program copayment by a certain amount; altering the eligibility requirements for the Maryland Pharmacy Assistance Program; limiting the services covered by the Maryland Pharmacy Assistance Program; providing for the effective dates of this Act; making this Act an emergency measure; providing that certain provisions may not be implemented prior to a certain date; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to the Maryland Pharmacy Assistance Program.
