SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- (a) (1) The Department shall maintain a Maryland Pharmacy Assistance Program for low income individuals {whose} WHO ARE:
  - (I) -AGE 55 OR ABOVE:
- (II) —DETERMINED ELIGIBLE FOR THE SOCIAL SECURITY DISABILITY INSURANCE PROGRAM:
- (III) DETERMINED ELIGIBLE FOR MEDICARE BENEFITS;
  - (IV) -HIV-POSITIVE.
- (2) THE MARYLAND PHARMACY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM SHALL BE AVAILABLE FOR INDIVIDUALS IDENTIFIED IN PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION WHOSE::
- (i) Assets are not more than 1.5 times the amount of accountable resources according to the asset schedule of the Maryland Medical Assistance Program; and
  - (ii) Gross annual income does not exceed:
  - 1. \$4,600 plus \$500 for each individual over 1 in a family unit;
- 2. An annual increase set by the Secretary under paragraph  $\{(2)\}$  (iii) of this subsection.
- $\{(2)\}$  (3) For the purpose of paragraph  $\{(1)\}$  (2) of this subsection, the Secretary shall:
  - (i) Define excluded assets;
  - (ii) Establish a family unit structure; and
- (iii) Beginning July 1, 1985, increase annually at the time social security benefits are increased, rounded to the next highest even \$50 level, the income level within which an individual is eligible for benefits under the Maryland Pharmacy Assistance Program by the larger of:
