

medical questions, rights of employees and applicants for employment concerning lie detector tests, rights of employees concerning certain volunteer activities, rights of certain employees concerning work on Sunday or the employee's Sabbath, pension plans, mediation of labor disputes, choice of bargaining representatives, injunctive relief for certain labor disputes, employer obligations concerning payment of certain union dues and certain benefits, liability of certain employees who refuse to leave certain property, liability of certain strikebreakers, certain trade disputes, occupational safety and health laws of the State, work near high voltage lines, licensing of farm labor contractors, responsibilities to migrant agricultural workers, unemployment insurance, workers' compensation, the Injured Workers' Insurance Fund, the Subsequent Injury Fund, and the Uninsured Employers' Fund; repealing certain obsolete provisions; adding short titles to certain laws; correcting certain cross-references; revising and transferring certain provisions relating to: workers' compensation insurance, employees of the Injured Workers' Insurance Fund, the liability of the Maryland Jockey Injury Compensation Fund, certain special elevator inspectors, effects on a corporation of failure to pay unemployment insurance taxes or make reimbursement payments, certain fees in connection with certain actions, clerical help for issuance of certain work permits, the surety bond of the State Treasurer, and the application of certain provisions to the Injured Workers' Insurance Fund; preserving the validity of certain seals and certain agreements; transferring certain provisions to the Session Laws; renaming a certain article; providing for the effective date of this Act; and generally relating to the labor and employment laws of the State.
