AN ACT concerning

Cecil County - Alcoholic Beverages Licenses

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Cecil County Board of License Commissioners to declare an alcoholic beverages license null and void under certain circumstances specifying the circumstances when an alcoholic beverages license in Cecil County is declared null and void.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

75.

- (F) IN CECIL COUNTY AN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE IS DECLARED NULL AND VOID IF A LICENSEE:
- (1) IS NO LONGER USING THE LICENSE AND HAS THE INTENTION OF TERMINATING THE BUSINESS OF THE LICENSED PREMISES; $\underline{\text{AND}}$
- (2) HAS NOT \underline{TIMELY} FILED A TRANSFER OF THE LICENSE WITH THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS PURSUANT TO § 74 OR § 78 OF THIS ARTICLE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991.
