- (2) Each local law enforcement agency and the State Fire Marshal shall provide the Department the information described in paragraph (1) of this subsection.
- (3) The Department shall adopt procedures for the collection and analysis of information described in paragraph (1) of this subsection.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991.

CHAPTER 412

(House Bill 864)

AN ACT concerning

Credit Reporting - Negative Information - Disclosure

FOR the purpose of providing that, after a reinvestigation of information in a consumer's file, the consumer reporting agency shall mail a certain notice to the consumer within a certain time under certain circumstances; providing that a person who provides certain adverse information about a consumer to a credit reporting agency or to a user shall provide a certain notice to the consumer within a certain period of time; providing for certain exceptions; providing that a violation of certain provisions is an unfair and deceptive trade practice; and generally relating to notices to a consumer regarding certain information bearing upon the consumer's creditworthiness.
