(B) IN MAKING THE APPOINTMENTS REQUIRED UNDER THIS SECTION, THE GOVERNOR SHALL ENSURE THAT THE COMMISSION IS REPRESENTATIVE OF:

(1) THE GEOGRAPHIC REGIONS OF THE STATE; AND

(2) MINORITY POPULATIONS OF THE STATE.

~~(B)~~ (C) THE TERM OF A MEMBER APPOINTED PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (A)(9) THROUGH (16) IS:

(1) 3 YEARS; AND

(2) STAGGERED.

~~(C)~~ (D) AT THE END OF A TERM, A MEMBER WHO IS APPOINTED PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (A)(9) THROUGH (16) OF THIS SECTION SHALL CONTINUE TO SERVE UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.

~~(D)~~ (E) A MEMBER WHO IS APPOINTED PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (A)(9) THROUGH (16) OF THIS SECTION AFTER A TERM HAS BEGUN SHALL SERVE FOR THE REST OF THE TERM OR UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.

~~(E)~~ (F) THE GOVERNOR SHALL APPOINT A SUCCESSOR IN THE EVENT OF A VACANCY ON THE COMMISSION.

~~(F)~~ (G) A MEMBER OF THE COMMISSION:

(1) MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION; BUT

(2) IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR REASONABLE EXPENSES INCURRED IN THE PERFORMANCE OF COMMISSION DUTIES, IN ACCORDANCE WITH STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS AND AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.

~~(G)~~ (H) FROM AMONG THE MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION, THE GOVERNOR SHALL DESIGNATE THE CHAIRMAN.

(A) A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS THEN SERVING ON THE COMMISSION IS A QUORUM.

(B) THE COMMISSION SHALL DETERMINE THE TIMES AND PLACES OF ITS MEETINGS AND ANY OTHER NECESSARY OPERATING PROCEDURES INCLUDING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF SUBCOMMITTEES OR WORKGROUPS UTILIZING THE EXPERTISE OF NONCOUNCIL MEMBERS.
