CHAPTER 420

(House Bill 949)

AN ACT concerning

Vehicle Laws – Driver's License Examination – Waiver

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Motor Vehicle Administration to waive a driver's license examination for certain license applicants; prohibiting a waiver of a vision examination; and generally relating to waivers of drivers' license examinations.

BY adding to

Article – Transportation

Section 16-110(g) and (h)

Annotated Code of Maryland

(1987 Replacement Volume and 1990 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Transportation

16-110.

(G) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (H) OF THIS SECTION, THE ADMINISTRATION MAY WAIVE ANY DRIVER'S LICENSE EXAMINATION PROVIDED FOR UNDER THIS TITLE IF THE APPLICANT:

(1) HOLDS A VALID DRIVER'S LICENSE ISSUED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE; OR

(2) HOLDS A VALID LICENSE FROM:

(I) ANOTHER STATE;

(II) A TERRITORY OR POSSESSION OF THE UNITED STATES, THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, OR THE COMMONWEALTH OF PUERTO RICO; OR

(III) A PROVINCE OR TERRITORY OF CANADA.

(H) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY NOT WAIVE A VISION EXAMINATION REQUIRED UNDER THIS SECTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991.
