- (f) The additional fee to the annual registration fee required by this section is not required for special registration of a vehicle that is exempt under § 13–903 of this title, or a vehicle with a special registration plate recognizing:
 - (1) The Maryland National Guard; or
- (2) A volunteer fire department, volunteer rescue squad, or volunteer ambulance company in this State.
- (g) (1) A special registration number as specified by the Administration and assigned under this section may consist of:
 - (i) Any combination of:
 - 1. Letters; and
 - 2. Numerals; and
- (ii) Any design approved by the Administration that adequately reflects the geographical, historical, natural resource, or environmental theme which the plate commemorates.
- (2) A special registration number or design assigned under this section shall be displayed on the registration plates for the vehicle.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991.

CHAPTER 431

(House Bill 1097)

AN ACT concerning

Vehicle Laws - Failure to Yield to Emergency Vehicles Penalties Passing an Emergency or Police Vehicle - Points

- FOR the purpose of providing for a mandatory fine for failure to yield to a certain emergency vehicle; increasing the number of points that may be assessed against an individual who fails to yield to an emergency vehicle; and generally relating to penalties for failure to yield to an emergency vehicle.
- FOR the purpose of increasing the number of points that shall be assessed against an individual who passes an emergency or police vehicle under certain circumstances; and generally relating to the assessment of points for a conviction for passing an emergency or police vehicle under certain circumstances.
