"SECRETARY" MEANS THE SECRETARY OF LICENSING AND REGULATION.

2-102. ESTABLISHED.

(A) IN GENERAL.

THERE IS A DIVISION OF LABOR AND INDUSTRY IN THE DEPARTMENT OF LICENSING AND REGULATION.

(B) AUTHORITY OF SECRETARY.

THE DIVISION EXERCISES ITS RIGHTS, POWERS, AND DUTIES SUBJECT TO THE AUTHORITY OF THE SECRETARY AS SET FORTH IN ARTICLE 41 OF THE CODE OR ELSEWHERE IN STATE LAW.
