- (4) The individual is not eligible for health insurance through another family member;
 - (5) A physician certifies that the individual is:
 - (i) HIV positive; and
- (ii) Due to this illness, the individual is either too ill to continue working in the individual's current position, or there is a substantial likelihood that within 3 months the individual will be unable to work; and
 - (6) The individual is a resident of the State.

- (a) The Department shall adopt regulations for the payment of health insurance premiums to insurance carriers or employers under the Program.
- (b) The Program shall pay the individual's health insurance premium in accordance with the provisions of [the]:
- (1) THE Consolidated Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act of 1985, P.L. 99-272, and any subsequent modifications to [the] THAT Act; AND

CHAPTER 448

(House Bill 1266)

AN ACT concerning

Regulation of Natural Wood Waste Recycling Facilities

FOR the purpose of establishing certain requirements for the operation of natural wood waste recycling facilities in the State; providing that those facilities may operate only in accordance with the provisions of this Act; authorizing the Department of the Environment to adopt additional regulations governing the storage of recyclable materials and the residues generated by the collection, separation, and processing of recyclable materials by requiring recycling facilities to obtain a permit from the Department of the Environment before the recycling facility is installed, altered, or extended certain recycling facilities; requiring the Department to establish a certain permit system on or before a certain date; providing for the renewal of the permit certain exemptions; providing for the enforcement of this Act; defining a certain
