- (I) A NONPROFIT <u>OR GOVERNMENTAL</u> ORGANIZATION LOCATED IN THE STATE; OR THAT IS:
  - 1. CHARITABLE;
  - 2. EDUCATIONAL; OR
  - 3. RELIGIOUS: AND
  - (II) THE AMERICAN RED CROSS;
- (III) A SINGLE INDIVIDUAL OR BUSINESS THAT PROVIDES RECYCLING SERVICES FOR ITS OWN EMPLOYEES OR FOR ITS OWN RECYCLABLE MATERIALS GENERATED ON ITS OWN PREMISES; AND

## (IV) SCRAP DEALERS AND RECYCLERS.

- (G) (H) "Recycling services" means the services provided by persons engaged in the business of recycling, including the collection, processing, storage, purchase, sale, or disposition of recyclable materials.
- [(g)]  $\frac{\text{(H)}}{\text{(I)}}$  "Resource recovery facility" means a facility in existence as of January 1, 1988 that:
- (1) Processes solid waste to produce valuable resources, including steam, electricity, metals, or refuse-derived fuel; and
- (2) Achieves a volume reduction of at least 50 percent of its solid waste stream.
- [(h)] (I) (J) (I) "Solid waste stream" means garbage or refuse that would, unless recycled, be disposed of in a refuse disposal system located in this State.
  - (2) "Solid waste stream" does not include:
    - (i) Hospital waste;
    - (ii) Rubble;
    - (iii) Scrap material;
    - (iv) Land clearing debris;
    - (v) Sewage sludge; or
- (vi) Waste generated by a single individual or business and disposed of in a facility dedicated solely for that entity's waste.
  - [(i)] (J) (K) "White goods" includes:
    - (1) Refrigerators;
    - (2) Stoves;
    - (3) Washing machines;
