

(2) THE CHIEF INSPECTOR:

(I) IS ENTITLED TO THE SALARY PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET; AND

(II) IS SUBJECT TO THE MERIT SYSTEM LAW.

(E) CHIEF MEDIATOR.

(1) THE COMMISSIONER MAY APPOINT A CHIEF MEDIATOR, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE GOVERNOR.

(2) THE CHIEF MEDIATOR:

(I) IS ENTITLED TO THE SALARY PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET; BUT

(II) MAY NOT RECEIVE ADDITIONAL COMPENSATION FOR SERVING ON A BOARD OF ARBITRATION.

(F) SAFETY INSPECTORS.

(1) THE COMMISSIONER SHALL APPOINT:

(I) SAFETY INSPECTORS WHO ARE QUALIFIED AND TRAINED IN OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY; AND

(II) SAFETY INSPECTORS WHO ARE QUALIFIED TECHNICALLY TO INSPECT AMUSEMENT RIDES AND AMUSEMENT ATTRACTIONS, ELEVATORS, AND WORKER AND MATERIAL HOISTS ON CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS AND WHO SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THOSE INSPECTIONS.

(2) EACH SAFETY INSPECTOR IS ENTITLED TO THE SALARY PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.

(G) OTHER STAFF.

THE COMMISSIONER MAY EMPLOY, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STATE BUDGET, OTHER STAFF NEEDED TO PERFORM THE DUTIES OF THE COMMISSIONER, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE GOVERNOR AND THE SECRETARY.

REVISOR'S NOTE: Subsection (a)(1), (2), and (4)(ii) and (iii) of this section is new language derived without substantive change from the eleventh and thirteenth sentences of former Art. 89, § 1.

Subsection (a)(3) of this section is standard language added to conform to the similar provisions in subsections (b)(3), (c)(2), and (d)(2)(i) of this section.

Subsection (a)(4)(i) of this section is new language added to clarify the authority of the deputy commissioner to perform any power or duty that the Commissioner delegates.
