- $\underline{\mbox{(I)}}$ An incumbent's performance in legislative office $\underline{\mbox{OR}_{;}\mbox{OR}}$
- (II) AN ISSUE OR ISSUES OF PUBLIC IMPORTANCE RELATING TO THAT LEGISLATIVE OFFICE CHOSEN BY THE INCUMBENT OR CANDIDATE.
- (II) "LEGISLATIVE NEWSLETTER" DOES NOT INCLUDE CORRESPONDENCE WITH PERSONS AS PART OF USUAL AND CUSTOMARY CONSTITUENT SERVICES, AS SET FORTH IN ARTICLE 40A, § 3-104 OF THE CODE.
