SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991. The provisions of this Act permitting the transfer of any class beer, wine and liquor (on-sale) retail licenses into the "Towson Town Center" in Baltimore County and the conversion of those licenses into Class B (TTC) licenses shall remain effective for a period of ~~5~~ 2 years and, at the end of June 30, ~~1996~~ 1993, and with no further action required by the General Assembly, those provisions shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

CHAPTER 453

(House Bill 1315)

AN ACT concerning

Horse Racing – Simulcasting – Mutuel Pools

FOR the purpose of allowing a person licensed to conduct horse racing to combine certain wagers made at the person's track with certain wagers made at certain out-of-state facilities to produce common mutuel pools for calculating odds and payouts; restricting the use of certain mutuel pools; providing for a certain takeout on common mutuel pools; and generally relating to simulcast wagering on horse racing.
