SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article 27 – Crimes and Punishments**

403B.

(f) (1) If a person is found by the District Court to have committed a Code violation, that person shall be required to pay a fine in an amount not to exceed \$500.

(2) If the violation is a repeat offense, that person shall be required to pay a fine in an amount not to exceed \$1,000.

~~(3) (1) IF A PERSON WHO IS AT LEAST 18 BUT UNDER 21 YEARS OF AGE IS ISSUED A CITATION FOR FALSE REPRESENTATION OF AGE TO ANY LICENSED INNKEEPER OR OTHER SELLER OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES TO BUY OR RECEIVE, BY SALE, GIFT, OR OTHERWISE, AN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE, THAT PERSON SHALL BE REQUIRED TO PAY A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000.~~
