

(II) ESTABLISH APPROPRIATE PROCEDURES FOR RECORDS, INSPECTIONS, AUDITS, OR OTHER REQUIREMENTS TO MONITOR CARE AND MAINTENANCE SERVICES PROVIDED DIRECTLY BY THE GUARDIAN OF THE PERSON FOR WHICH THE GUARDIAN OF THE PERSON IS REIMBURSED; AND

(III) ORDER ANY ACT NECESSARY FOR THE BEST INTERESTS OF THE DISABLED PERSON.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991.

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**CHAPTER 459**

**(House Bill 358)**

AN ACT concerning

**Merit System – Incentive Awards for State Employees**

FOR the purpose of providing incentive cash awards in certain amounts for certain State employees for certain innovative ideas; providing incentive cash awards and additional paid leave and other awards for certain State employees who demonstrate outstanding or extraordinary service; defining certain terms; providing for certain reports; repealing existing incentive award programs; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to incentive awards for State employees.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section(s) 32A of Article 64A – Merit System of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed.
