SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 64A - Merit System

INCENTIVE AWARDS

32A.

- (A) IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.
- (B) (1) "EMPLOYEE" MEANS ANY INDIVIDUAL WHO IS EMPLOYED BY A UNIT IN THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH OF STATE GOVERNMENT AS:
 - (I) A CLASSIFIED EMPLOYEE;
 - (II) AN UNCLASSIFIED EMPLOYEE; OR
 - (III) A CONTRACTUAL EMPLOYEE.
- (2) "EMPLOYEE" DOES NOT INCLUDE ANY INDIVIDUAL WHO HOLDS A POSITION THAT IS INCLUDED IN THE EXECUTIVE PAY PLAN.
- (C) "UNIT" MEANS A PRINCIPAL DEPARTMENT OR ANY OTHER COMPARABLE UNIT IN THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH OF STATE GOVERNMENT, INCLUDING A UNIT WITH INDEPENDENT AUTHORITY TO SET SALARIES.
- (D) "INNOVATIVE IDEA" INCLUDES ANY SUGGESTION OR INVENTION.

32B.

- (A) THERE IS AN INNOVATIVE IDEA AWARD PROGRAM FOR EMPLOYEES.
- (B) (1) AN INNOVATIVE IDEA AWARD MAY BE AWARDED FOR AN INNOVATIVE IDEA, WHICH IF IMPLEMENTED, WOULD RESULT IN:
 - (I) MONETARY SAVINGS TO THE STATE;
 - (II) INCREASED REVENUES TO THE STATE;
- (III) AN IMPROVED QUALITY OF SERVICES DELIVERED TO THE PUBLIC; OR
 - (IV) ANY OTHER SIGNIFICANT BENEFIT TO THE STATE.
- (2) EXCEPT UNDER EXCEPTIONAL CIRCUMSTANCES, A CASH AWARD MAY NOT BE MADE FOR AN INNOVATIVE IDEA THAT IS UNDER ACTIVE STUDY OR CONTINUAL REVIEW BY ANY UNIT OF STATE GOVERNMENT.
