- (II) IF THE RECIPIENT CONTINUES TO TEACH IN A PUBLIC SCHOOL IN THIS STATE IN THAT ACADEMIC FIELD, INVOKE THE PROVISIONS OF § 18–701 (E) (1) OF THIS SUBTITLE OR DISQUALIFY THE RECIPIENT UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF § 18–701 (E) (2) OF THIS SUBTITLE.
- (H) FUNDS FOR THE TEACHER EDUCATION TUITION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM SHALL BE AS PROVIDED IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET OF THE COMMISSION BY THE GOVERNOR.

18-704.

- (A) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.
- (1) "ELIGIBLE INSTITUTION" MEANS AN ACCREDITED COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY THAT HAS A PROGRAM OF UNDERGRADUATE STUDIES THAT WOULD LEAD TO LICENSING AS A PHYSICAL THERAPIST, PHYSICAL THERAPY ASSISTANT, OCCUPATIONAL THERAPIST, OR OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY ASSISTANT.
- (2) "ELIGIBLE PROGRAM" MEANS AN UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAM NECESSARY FOR LICENSING AS A PHYSICAL THERAPIST, PHYSICAL THERAPY ASSISTANT, OCCUPATIONAL THERAPIST, OR OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY ASSISTANT.
- (3) "HANDICAPPED CHILD" HAS THE MEANING SET FORTH IN § 8–401 OF THIS TITLE.
- (4) "OCCUPATIONAL THERAPIST" AND "OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY ASSISTANT" HAVE THE MEANINGS SET FORTH IN § 9–101 OF THE HEALTH OCCUPATIONS ARTICLE.
- (5) "PHYSICAL THERAPIST" AND "PHYSICAL THERAPIST ASSISTANT" HAVE THE MEANINGS SET FORTH IN § 13–101 OF THE HEALTH OCCUPATIONS ARTICLE.
- (6) "RECIPIENT" MEANS A RECIPIENT OF TUITION ASSISTANCE UNDER THIS SECTION.
- (7) "TUITION ASSISTANCE" MEANS ANY FUNDS PROVIDED FOR THE COST OF BASIC INSTRUCTIONAL CHARGES, FEES, ROOM, BOARD, OR OTHER RELATED EDUCATIONAL EXPENSES.
- (8) (I) "SERVICE OBLIGATION" MEANS THE OBLIGATION OF RECIPIENTS TO PROVIDE PHYSICAL OR OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY TO HANDICAPPED CHILDREN IN A PUBLIC SCHOOL IN MARYLAND OR HANDICAPPED CHILDREN PLACED IN A NONPUBLIC EDUCATION PROGRAM AS PROVIDED UNDER § 8–409 OF THIS ARTICLE, THE FIRST YEAR OF WHICH IS PROVIDED UNDER THE FULL-TIME, ON-SITE SUPERVISION OF A LICENSED PHYSICAL OR OCCUPATIONAL THERAPIST WHO HAS AT LEAST 2 YEARS' EXPERIENCE IN A SCHOOL PROGRAM.
