

(1) THE REPORT SHALL DESCRIBE THE ACTIVITIES OF THE DIVISION DURING THE PRECEDING YEAR.

(2) THE REPORT SHALL INCLUDE A DESCRIPTION OF ITS INVESTIGATIONS UNDER § 5-205(I) OF THIS ARTICLE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 89, § 30(j)(2) and the third sentence of § 2(2).

In subsection (a) of this section, the word "submit" is substituted for the former words "prepare and deliver" for conformity to Art. 89, § 30(j)(2) and for brevity, since "submit[ing]" encompasses both "preparing" and "delivering".

Also in subsection (a) of this section, the former words "if requested" are deleted as obsolete in light of the referenced SG § 2-1312, which requires a unit to submit to the Department of Legislative Reference 5 copies of each report that the unit issues and intends to distribute to the General Assembly.

Subsection (b) of this section is revised to include the description of investigations under § 5-205(i) of this article in the annual report although former Art. 89, § 30(j)(2) did not require the report on investigations to be submitted to the Governor or Secretary and did not specify a date for submitting the report. It did not seem that the General Assembly intended to require a separate annual report, since the investigations are part of the "activities of the Division". In any event, the Governor, as chief executive, and the Secretary, under Art. 41, § 8-104(d) of the Code, should receive copies of the report.

2-109. TERMINATION OF STATUTES AND REGULATIONS.

SUBJECT TO THE EVALUATION AND REESTABLISHMENT PROVISIONS OF THE MARYLAND PROGRAM EVALUATION ACT, THE FOLLOWING PROVISIONS RELATED TO THE REGULATION OF LABOR AND INDUSTRY AND ALL REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER THESE PROVISIONS SHALL TERMINATE AND BE OF NO EFFECT AFTER JULY 1, 1994:

- (1) THIS TITLE;
- (2) TITLE 3, SUBTITLES 2 AND 4 OF THIS ARTICLE;
- (3) TITLE 4, SUBTITLES 1 AND 2 AND § 4-403 OF THIS ARTICLE;
- (4) TITLE 5 OF THIS ARTICLE.
