- (ii) As to the funding priority of any institution, may comment only on the entity as a whole and not on any separate unit of the institution.
- (5) (i) The Governor shall include in the annual budget submission for fiscal year 1990 an amount of General Fund State support for each public senior higher education institution equal to at least the following amounts:

- (ii) For fiscal year 1991 and each fiscal year thereafter, it is the goal of the State that public senior higher education institutions be funded at a level at least equal to 100 percent of the funding guideline set by the Commission.

- (3) (I) WHENEVER A COUNTY DESIRES, OR WHENEVER THE COUNTIES THAT SUPPORT A REGIONAL COMMUNITY COLLEGE DESIRE, TO PARTICIPATE IN THE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE PROVIDED BY THE STATE FOR THE GENERAL PUBLIC JUNIOR OR COMMUNITY COLLEGE AND
