

[(k)] (M) Subject to the provisions of § 11-401 of this title, the Commission shall serve as the repository for records of defunct institutions of postsecondary education.

[(l)] (N) Subject to the provisions of § 11-203 of this title, the Commission may require bonds or other financial guaranties from institutions of postsecondary education seeking certification or recertification to operate in the State.

[(m)](O) Subject to the provisions of § 11-402 of this title, the Commission shall regulate the solicitation of students by institutions of postsecondary education.

[(n)] (P) The Commission shall recommend to the Governor and General Assembly appropriate revisions to the Charter.

[(o)] (Q) The Commission shall arbitrate to resolve differences among the segments of higher education in the State.

[(p)] (R) The Commission shall establish and maintain a higher education information system for planning, coordination, and evaluation purposes.

[(q)] (S) The Commission may adopt any rule or regulation necessary to carry out its powers and duties.

[(r)] (T) (1) The Commission, with the advice of the Secretary, shall adopt regulations for the New Community College of Baltimore describing the categories of actions having significant financial consequences that require prior approval of the Secretary before final action of the Board of Trustees of the New Community College of Baltimore.

(2) Notwithstanding paragraph (1) of this subsection, dispositions of any property or license, pursuant to § 16-605(e)(2) of this article and use of any proceeds or income pursuant to § 16-605(e)(3)(ii)2 of this article do not require the prior approval of the Secretary.

[(s)] (U) The Commission shall perform any other duty delegated to it in accordance with law.

(b) (1) The governing body of any county that does not have a community college may request permission to establish one from the Maryland Higher Education Commission [and the State Board for Community Colleges].

16-203.

(a) In addition to the other powers granted and duties imposed by this title, and subject to the authority of the Maryland Higher Education Commission [and the State Board for Community Colleges], each board of community college trustees has the powers and duties set forth in this section.

(b) With the approval of the Maryland Higher Education Commission, [on recommendation of the State Board for Community Colleges,] each board of trustees may establish and operate one or more community colleges.
