16-303.

(a) The [State Board for Community Colleges] COMMISSION shall determine and certify the amount that each county that supports a regional community college shall pay as its share of the "county share" required by § 16–403 of this title. The amount shall be determined by applying to the total county share the ratio that the number of full-time equivalent students from the county who attend the regional community college bears to the total number of full-time students who attend the regional community college from all counties that support the regional community college.

16-401.

- (g) (1) The budget of each community college, as approved by the county governing body under this section shall be submitted to the [State Board for Community Colleges] COMMISSION for informational purposes. This budget shall include a personnel detail.
- (2) Proposals for capital projects shall be submitted to the Department of Budget and Fiscal Planning through the [State Board for Community Colleges] COMMISSION.

16-402.

- (b) (1) The county governing body shall make appropriations by major functions established by the [State Board for Community Colleges] COMMISSION.
- (2) The major functions established by the [State Board for Community Colleges] COMMISSION shall conform generally to those contained in the then-current College and University Industry Audit Guide issued by the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants.

16-403.1.

- (a) (1) In addition to any other State aid for community colleges there is a supplemental funding program.
- (2) The program shall be administered by the [State Board for Community Colleges] COMMISSION as provided in this section.
- (3) The [State Board for Community Colleges] COMMISSION may adopt reasonable rules and regulations to carry out the supplemental funding program.

16-404.

(b) For EACH fiscal year [1987 and each fiscal year thereafter], the [State Board for Community Colleges] COMMISSION shall submit a budget request to the Governor on or before October 10 of each year calculated by using the formulas in §§ 16–403, 16–403.1, and 16–403.2 of this subtitle and the actual systemwide full-time equivalent student enrollment of the community colleges in this State in the fiscal year 2 years prior to the fiscal year in which the payments are made.
