The State Board of Education, the Maryland Higher Education Commission, [the State Board for Community Colleges,] the Department of Human Resources, the Department of Economic and Employment Development, the Board of Regents of the University of Maryland System, the Governor's Employment and Training Council, and all other appropriate State agencies shall cooperate with the State Council on Vocational–Technical Education in supplying any studies and reports requested by the Council. In return, the Council shall supply copies of its reports and studies on request. 22–101.

- (a) There is an Education Coordinating Council for Correctional Institutions under the jurisdiction of the Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services which is within the State Department of Education for administrative and budgetary purposes.
 - (b) (1) The Council consists of five members.
- (2) One of the members shall be a resident of this State appointed by the Governor for a term of 4 years and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
 - (3) The following officials shall serve ex officio:
 - (i) The State Superintendent of Schools;
 - (ii) The Commissioner of Correction;
- (iii) [The Executive Director of the State Board for Community Colleges] THE SECRETARY OF HIGHER EDUCATION; and
- (iv) The county superintendent of schools from a county where a correctional institution of the Division of Correction is located, who shall be selected by the State Superintendent.

(d) Each year, the Secretary shall report to the General Assembly, in accordance with § 2–1312 of the State Government Article, the Governor, AND the Maryland Higher Education Commission[, and the State Board for Community Colleges] on the number and types of areas of shortage and the projected statewide employment vacancy rates in hospitals and related institutions.
