

(b) (1) The Advisory Committee shall consist of the following members or their respective designees:

- (i) The Commissioner shall serve as an ex officio member;
- (ii) The State Comptroller;
- (iii) The Secretary of the Department of General Services;
- (iv) Two members of the General Assembly, one of whom shall be appointed by the Speaker of the House of Delegates and one of whom shall be appointed by the President of the Senate;
- (v) [The Executive Director of the State Board for Community Colleges] THE SECRETARY OF HIGHER EDUCATION;
- (vi) The State Superintendent of Schools, Department of Education;
- (vii) The Secretary of the Department of Economic and Employment Development;
- (viii) The Secretary of Budget and Fiscal Planning;
- (ix) The Secretary of the Department of Agriculture;
- (x) The Director of Patuxent Institution; and
- (xi) Four members of private industry, who shall be appointed by the Governor for terms of 3 years each, beginning July 1, 1981. Two of these members shall be representatives of management, and two of these members shall be representatives of organized labor.

(a) (2) "Institution" means any campus of the University of Maryland System, any community college [controlled by the State Board for Community Colleges] ESTABLISHED PURSUANT TO TITLE 16 OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE, Morgan State University, or St. Mary's College.

(4) (c) For members of this retirement system whose compensation is not paid by the State, the State Department of Education and the [State Board for Community Colleges] MARYLAND HIGHER EDUCATION COMMISSION shall certify to the Comptroller on the last day of September, December, and May, and the 15th of April one quarter of the amount appropriated in the budget of the State Department of Education and the [State Board for Community Colleges] MARYLAND HIGHER EDUCATION COMMISSION for the employers' contributions to this retirement system.
