(a) The optional retirement program provided for in this section may be adopted by any of the following boards with respect to the institution or institutions governed by that board or with respect to that board's own staff:

(1) Board of Regents of the University of Maryland System;

(2) Board of Trustees of St. Mary's College of Maryland;

(3) [State Board for Community Colleges] MARYLAND HIGHER EDUCATION COMMISSION with respect to THE COMMISSION AND any community college or regional community college established under Title 16 of the Education Article;

[(4) Maryland Higher Education Commission;] and

[(5)] (4) Board of Regents of Morgan State University.

(4) (c) For members of this pension system whose compensation is not paid by the State, the State Department of Education and the [State Board for Community Colleges] MARYLAND HIGHER EDUCATION COMMISSION shall certify to the Comptroller on the last day of September, December, and May, and the 15th day of April one quarter of the amount appropriated in the budget of the State Department of Education and the [State Board for Community Colleges] MARYLAND HIGHER EDUCATION COMMISSION for the employers' contributions to this pension system. The Comptroller shall draw a warrant or warrants on the State Treasurer on or before the first day of October, January, and June, and the 16th day of April for the amounts certified. On receipt of the warrant, the State Treasurer shall immediately transfer to the pension system the amounts due.

#### **Article 83A – Department of Economic and Employment Development**

3-502.

(a) (1) There is a Partnership for Workforce Quality Advisory Board as part of the Department of Economic and Employment Development.

(2) (i) The Board shall consult on a regular basis with the Governor's Employment and Training Council concerning the activities of the Partnership for Workforce Quality Program.

(ii) The Board shall submit a quarterly report on the Program to the Governor's Employment and Training Council.
