- (a) A person may not knowingly make or cause to be made any false statement or report in any document required to be furnished to the [Department] ADMINISTRATION by any agreement relating to financial assistance.
- (b) A person applying for financial assistance may not knowingly make or cause any false statement or report to be made for the purpose of influencing any action of the [Department] ADMINISTRATION on an application for financial assistance or for the purpose of influencing any action of the [Department] ADMINISTRATION affecting financial assistance already provided.
- (c) Any person who violates any provision of subsection (a) or (b) of this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to a fine not exceeding \$50,000 or imprisonment not exceeding 1 year or both.

The three members of the "Southern States Energy Board" from the State of Maryland shall be appointed as follows:

- (1) 1 member by the [Secretary of Natural Resources] DIRECTOR OF THE MARYLAND ENERGY ADMINISTRATION, with the approval of the Governor; this member's term of office shall be coterminous with that of the appointing Governor;
- (2) One member from and by the Maryland House of Delegates, whose term of office shall be coterminous with that of the appointing House of Delegates;
- (3) One member from and by the Maryland Senate, whose term of office shall be coterminous with that of the appointing Senate.
