(House Bill 206)

AN ACT concerning

The Budget Management Reconciliation Act

FOR the purpose of reducing the General Fund shortfall for fiscal years 1991 and 1992 by ~~authorizing~~ requiring the Governor to transfer to the General Fund certain amounts from certain special funds before a certain date ~~or for certain fiscal years~~; altering the distribution of funds recovered by the State Deposit Insurance Fund; altering the condition under which the Governor shall include an appropriation to the Revenue Stabilization Account of the State Reserve Fund; altering the conditions under which the Governor may transfer funds from the Revenue Stabilization Account of the State Reserve Fund; ~~authorizing the transfer in both fiscal years 1991 and 1992 of certain amounts~~ fiscal year 1991 of a certain amount of funds from the Transportation Trust Fund to the general funds of this State; and providing for the effective date of this Act; crediting certain assessed motor vehicle penalties of certain amounts to the general fund for fiscal years 1991 and 1992; authorizing the expenditure of certain cash proceeds from the sale of certain properties retained by the University of Maryland without restriction on or after a certain date; authorizing the transfer of funds between certain accounts in the Department of Economic and Employment Development up to a certain amount and for a certain fiscal year; repealing a certain requirement that the counties and Baltimore City comply with a certain provision of law for a certain fiscal year; providing for the calculation of certain levels of appropriations by certain local governing bodies for a certain fiscal year; authorizing the Secretary of Transportation to transfer funds not exceeding a certain amount from the Motorcycle Safety Program Account to the Transportation Trust Fund; requiring the State to pay social security contributions for fiscal year 1992, based on a certain wage base, plus contributions associated with certain new positions and certain ~~steps and increments~~ salary increases, for any Board of Education, Library Board of Trustees, or Community College Board of Trustees; prohibiting the State from making certain social security contributions under certain circumstances; restricting the manner by which the Governor may reduce certain appropriations under certain circumstances for fiscal year 1992; authorizing State aid for basic current expenses ~~and certain social security contributions and certain social security contributions~~ to be reduced by up to a certain amount and in a certain manner for fiscal year 1992; requiring the Governor to appropriate a certain amount of funds to the Revenue Stabilization Account of the State Reserve Fund for a certain fiscal year; authorizing the Governor to transfer to the general fund certain funds from the Maryland Emergency Medical System Fund for a certain purpose in fiscal year 1992; ~~providing a certain restriction on the distribution of the State share of basic current expenses under certain circumstances; requiring a board of education, a board of community college trustees, or a board of library trustees to pay for certain retirement or pension system costs under certain circumstances; authorizing a certain transfer~~ certain transfers of funds by approved budget amendment for certain purposes in certain fiscal years; providing for
