- (12) Up to \$2,000,000 of the funds in the account of the Maryland Food Center Authority established under Title 13 of Article 41, provided that the amount transferred will reduce the outstanding balance of the loan to the Maryland Food Center Authority made pursuant to Chapter 409 of the Acts of 1969 (the General Construction Loan of 1969); and
- (13) All funds remaining in the account of the Enterprise Zone Venture Capital Guarantee Fund established under Article 83A, § 5-305;
- (14) Up-to \$10,000,000 of the funds in the accounts of the Waterway Improvement Fund established under § 8-707 of the Natural Resources Article; and
- (15) Up-te \$2,500,000 of the funds in the Rental Housing Programs Fund established under § 2-805 of Article 83B.

## SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, for fiscal year 1991 only, up to \$22,200,000 of the funds in the Transportation Trust Fund which are not required by law to be distributed to the Counties or Baltimore City and which have not been pledged or otherwise committed to the payment of or as security for the payment of any bonds or debt issued or incurred pursuant to the Transportation Article may shall be transferred by appropriate action of the Governor to the General Fund after June 1, 1991.

Notwithstanding any other provision of the law, for fiscal year 1992 only, up to \$53,620,000 of the funds in the Transportation Trust Fund which are not required by law to be distributed to the Counties or Baltimore City and which have not been pledged or otherwise committed to the payment of or as security for the payment of any bonds or debt issued or incurred pursuant to the Transportation Articlemay be transferred by appropriate action of the Governor to the General Fund after June 1, 1992.

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, for fiscal year 1992 only, \$1,915,000 shall be withheld each month from the moneys designated for distribution to Baltimore City and the Counties and Municipalities pursuant to Section 8-403 of the Transportation Article and may be transferred by appropriate action of the Governor to the General Fund after June 1, 1992.

- SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That for fiscal year 1992, notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Governor may shall transfer to the General Fund:
- (1) Up to \$7,500,000 of the funds in the account for unclaimed lottery prizes under § 9-122(e) of the State Government Article;
- (2) Up to \$5,500,000 of the funds in the account of the Maryland Stadium Facilities Fund established under § 7-312 of the Financial Institutions Article;
- (3) Up to \$18,000,000 \$9,962,000 \$12,000,000 of the funds in the accounts for State Projects and \$4,500,000 in the accounts for Local Projects under Title 5, Subtitle 9 (Program Open Space) of the Natural Resources Article;
