- (V) INSTRUCTING ON AN INSTRUCTIONAL SAILBOAT;
- (VI) DELIVERY OF NEWSPAPERS TO CONSUMERS;
- (VII) MAKING AN EVERGREEN WREATH IN OR ABOUT A HOME; OR
- (VIII) WORK THAT IS PERFORMED AS AN UNPAID VOLUNTEER IN A CHARITABLE OR NOT FOR PROFIT ORGANIZATION, IF:
- 1. A PARENT OF THE MINOR OR A PERSON STANDING IN THE PLACE OF THE PARENT CONSENTS IN WRITING; AND
- 2. FOR HAZARDOUS WORK IN A VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT OR COMPANY OR VOLUNTEER RESCUE SQUAD, THE MINOR:
 - A. IS AT LEAST 16 YEARS OLD; AND
- B. HAS COMPLETED OR IS TAKING A COURSE OF STUDY ABOUT FIRE FIGHTING OR RESCUE.
 - REVISOR'S NOTE: Items (1), (2), and (4) of this section are new language derived without substantive change from items (1) through (8) and (10) and the exclusion of activities in the introductory language of former Art. 100, § 4(c).
 - Item (3) of this section is new language substituted for former Art. 100, § 4(d), which defined "[h]azardous occupation" by reference to former § 7(d) and the federal Fair Labor Standards Act, and the reference to "hazardous occupations" in the introductory language of (c). This substitution reflects that the former seemingly broad prohibition against performing a hazardous occupation was limited by the exceptions in former § 4(c)(9) and in the formerly referenced § 7(d). See §§ 3–206 and 3–213 of this subtitle.

This section is revised as an exclusion of certain activities from the scope of this subtitle, rather than as part of the definition of "[e]mploy", for accuracy, since, in fact, the activities could constitute employment.

In item (1) of this section, the reference to school "hours set for that minor" is substituted for the former reference to a "prescribed school day", to reflect that school days and hours for specific students vary.

In item (4)(iii) and (viii)1 of this section, the phrase "of the minor" is added for clarity.

Also in item (4)(iii) and (viii)1 of this section, the word "person" is substituted for the former word "one" for consistency with other references in this subtitle. See, e.g., § 3-207(d)(1) of this subtitle.
