Notwithstanding any provision of State law to the contrary including, but not limited to the procurement provisions of the State Finance and Procurement Article, and subject to the approval of the Board of Public Works, the Maryland Environmental Service shall be responsible for and control procurement of equipment, construction, engineering and architectural services, and all related services and supplies for projects and public improvements for which State funds are hereby appropriated to the Maryland Environmental Service.....
