**Chapter 597 of the Acts of 1987, as amended by Chapter 421 of the Acts of 1990**

Section 1

[(i)] (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the General Construction Loan of 1987 in the total principal amount of \$99,789,000. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale, and delivery of State general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public Works and issued, sold, and delivered in accordance with Sections 8-117 through 8-124 of the State Finance and Procurement Article and Article 31, Section 22 of the Code.
