- (1) THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES HAS SUBMITTED TO THE BUDGET COMMITTEES AN **APPROVED** PROGRAM PLAN AND A PROPOSED SITE PLAN FOR THE PRISON THAT CONTAINS INFORMATION ON THE EXISTENCE AND LOCATION OF INFRASTRUCTURE, INCLUDING ELECTRICITY, WATER, AND WASTEWATER TREATMENT; AND
- (2) THE BUDGET COMMITTEES HAVE REVIEWED AND COMMENTED ON THE PROGRAM PLAN AND THE PROPOSED SITE PLAN FOR THE PROJECT, OR 45 DAYS HAVE ELAPSED FROM THE DATE THAT THE PROGRAM AND SITE INFORMATION IS RECEIVED BY THE COMMITTEES.....

- (i) The budget committees have received the final design and cost estimate for the Occupational Skills Training Center, as well as an explanation of the increases in square footage and capital equipment costs, and
- (ii) The budget committees have reviewed and commented upon the design and cost estimate for the projects, or 45 days have elapsed from the date the design is received by the committees......
