

of the fund may consist of real property, in kind contributions, or funds expended prior to the effective date of this Act. In case of any dispute as to the amount of the matching fund or what money or assets may qualify as matching funds, the Board of Public Works shall determine the matter, and the Board's decision is final. The Academy of the Arts, Inc. has until June 1, 1994 1993 to present evidence satisfactory to the Board of Public Works that a matching fund will be provided. If satisfactory evidence is presented, the Board shall certify this fact and the amount of the matching fund to the State Treasurer, and the proceeds of the loan equal to the amount of the matching fund shall be expended for the purposes provided in this Act. Any amount of the loan in excess of the amount of the matching fund certified by the Board of Public Works shall be canceled and be of no further effect.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1991.

~~FOR the purpose of continuing the State Board of Barbers in accordance with the provisions of the Maryland Program Evaluation Act by extending to a certain date the termination provision relating to the statutory and regulatory authority of the Board and the regulation of barbers; repealing an assistant barber license; increasing the compensation paid to members of the Board and inspectors; altering the requirements for licensure as a barber teacher or an assistant barber teacher; increasing certain licensing and renewal fees; altering the requirements for licensure of certain barbers from other states; authorizing the Secretary of the Department of Licensing and Regulation to stagger the expiration and renewal of certain licenses; repealing an assistant barber teacher license; altering a certain ground for discipline; authorizing the Board to impose a certain penalty; establishing certain criteria to determine the amount of a certain penalty; repealing a certain ratio relating to journey barbers to master barbers; making certain technical changes; and generally relating to the regulation of the barber industry.~~
