~~(1) under the supervision of a master barber in a barbershop that holds a barbershop permit; and~~

- ~~(2) restricted to:~~

 - ~~(ii) removal of a hair solution;~~
 - ~~(iii) sterilization of equipment; or~~
 - ~~(iv) similar activities.]~~

~~(e) Before a license expires, the licensee periodically may renew it for an additional 2 year term, if the licensee:~~

- ~~(1) otherwise is entitled to be licensed;~~

 - ~~(ii) \$50 for a barber teacher license; OR~~
