sufficient to cover certain costs; eliminating certain licensing requirements; eliminating certain registration requirements; altering certain licensing requirements; altering the requirements for license of certain barbers from other states; altering certain requirements relating to the regulation of barber schools; specifying that the Board may adopt regulations to ensure that each barber school is operated in a sanitary manner; specifying certain procedures that the Board must follow on the filing of certain complaints; eliminating certain provisions relating to misrepresentation to the public regarding barber schools and the teaching of barbering; limiting the number of terms a Board member may serve; and generally relating to the regulation of the barber industry.

- (a) In this title the following words have the meanings indicated.
- (b) "Apprentice Barber" means an individual who, under the supervision of a master barber, is learning to practice barbering in a barbershop that holds a barbershop permit.
 - (c) "Barber" means an individual who practices barbering.
- (d) (1) "Barbershop" means an commercial establishment, except a beauty salon, in which an individual practices barbering.
- (2) "Barbershop" does not include a clinic in a barber school [that holds a school permit].
