- (iv) if authorized by that person, information about any complaint against that person.
- (c) The Board shall collect [a fee of \$10] THE CERTIFICATION FEE ESTABLISHED BY THE BOARD IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 4-206 OF THIS SUBTITLE for each certification under this section.

4-206.

- (a) (1) In addition to any powers set forth elsewhere, the Board may adopt any regulation to carry out this title.
- (2) (I) THE BOARD SHALL ESTABLISH REASONABLE FEES FOR LICENSING, LICENSING RENEWAL, REINSTATEMENT, CERTIFICATION, APPLICATIONS, PREOPENING INSPECTIONS, PER DIEM FEES FOR BOARD MEMBERS, COMPENSATION FOR INSPECTORS APPOINTED BY THE BOARD, AND ANY OTHER SERVICE PERFORMED BY THE BOARD NECESSARY TO CARRY OUT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS TITLE.
- (II) THE FEES ESTABLISHED BY THE BOARD SHALL BE SET IN A MANNER THAT WILL PRODUCE FUNDS SUFFICIENT TO COVER THE ACTUAL DIRECT AND INDIRECT COSTS OF REGULATING THE BARBER INDUSTRY IN THIS STATE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS TITLE.
- (III) THE TOTAL COST OF REGULATING THE BARBER INDUSTRY IN THIS STATE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS TITLE MAY NOT BE MORE THAN THE REVENUES GENERATED BY THE FEES ESTABLISHED UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH.
- (b) In addition to any duties set forth elsewhere, the Board shall administer and enforce this title.

4-301.

- (a) [(1)] Except as otherwise provided in this title, an individual shall be licensed by the Board to practice barbering before the individual may practice barbering in the State.
 - [(2)] (B) This [subsection] SECTION does not apply to:
- [(i)] (1) a registered student while the student practices barbering in a barber school [that holds a school permit] APPROVED BY THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION OR THE MARYLAND HIGHER EDUCATION COMMISSION;
 - [(ii)] (2) a registered apprentice barber; or
- [(iii)](3) an individual authorized in the discretion of the Board to practice barbering under special circumstances.
