- (i) to enroll and participate as a student in a barber school that holds a school permit; and
 - (ii) to practice barbering at the barber school.
 - (2) (i) A student shall practice barbering only at the barber school.
 - (ii) A student may not be paid for work authorized under this section.
- (b) (1)] While registration as an apprentice barber is in effect, the registration authorizes the individual to learn to practice barbering:
 - [(i)] (1) in a barbershop that holds a barbershop permit; and
 - [(ii)] (2) under the supervision of a master barber.
- [(2) (i)] (B) (1) An apprentice barber shall practice barbering only at the barbershop.
- [(ii)] (2) An apprentice barber may only be paid for work authorized under this section performed while assisting a master barber in starting or completing an operation.

4-405.

- (a) (1) The initial term of registration as an apprentice barber is 2 years.
- (2) Before the initial term of registration as an apprentice barber expires, the apprentice barber shall take the journey barber examination.
- (3) If an apprentice barber fails the journey barber examination, the apprentice barber may renew the apprentice barber registration 1 time with the approval of the Board.
- (b) The 1 time renewal of an apprentice barber registration is effective until the first May 31 that comes:
 - (1) after the first renewal is issued; and
 - (2) in an odd-numbered year.
- (c) At least 1 month before registration as an apprentice barber expires, the Board shall mail to the apprentice barber, at the last known address of the apprentice barber:
 - (1) a renewal application form; and
 - (2) a notice that states:
- (i) the date on which the current registration as an apprentice barber expires;
- (ii) the date by which the Board must receive the renewal application for the renewal to be approved, issued, and mailed before the registration expires; and
