- (a) Unless a barbershop permit is renewed for a 2-year term as provided in this section, the permit expires on the first May 31 that comes:
 - (1) after the effective date of the permit; and
 - (2) in an odd-numbered year.
- (b) At least 1 month before a barbershop permit expires, the Board shall mail to the permit holder, at the last known address of the holder:
 - (1) a renewal application form; and
 - (2) a notice that states:
 - (i) the date on which the current permit expires;
- (ii) the date by which the Board must receive the renewal application for the renewal to be issued and mailed before the permit expires; and
 - (iii) the amount of the renewal fee.
- (c) Before a barbershop permit expires, the barbershop permit holder periodically may renew it for an additional 2-year term, if the holder:
 - (1) otherwise is entitled to hold the permit;
