

(2) A TOTAL OF 3 APPRENTICE BARBERS.

4-508.

(a) Except as otherwise provided in this section, a barbershop may not be integrated with any other business.

(b) A person may conduct another business on the premises of a barbershop only if the business and barbershop are separated by a permanent wall or partition.

(c) (1) [Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, an] AN individual LICENSED TO PRACTICE COSMETOLOGY may practice cosmetology in a barbershop [only if the practice is conducted under the supervision of a manager licensed by the State Board of Cosmetologists].

(2) An individual who holds a limited license to provide manicuring services issued under Title 5 of this article[:

(i)] may provide manicuring services in a barbershop[; and

(ii) is not subject to the supervision requirement of paragraph (1) of this subsection].

[4-511.

(a) A person shall hold a school permit issued by the Board before the person may operate a barber school in the State.

(b) A separate school permit is required for each barber school that a person operates.]

[4-512.

(a) To qualify for a school permit, an applicant shall satisfy the Board that the barber school for which the application is made will be operated in accordance with the standards in § 4-513 of this subtitle.

(b) As a condition of the issuance of a school permit, the barber school for which the application is made shall pass an inspection conducted under § 4-522 of this subtitle.]

[4-513.

Each barber school shall:

(1) have a curriculum sufficient to train students;

(2) employ a sufficient number of teachers and other staff;

(3) have adequate physical facilities; and

(4) have an adequate administration.]
