SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

~~(d) (1) “Beauty salon permit” means a permit issued by the Board to operate a beauty salon.~~

~~(2) “Beauty salon permit” includes an owner manager permit.~~

~~(g) “Cosmetology school” means an establishment that operates as:~~

~~(2) a postgraduate school of cosmetology.~~

~~(h) (1) “License” means, unless the context requires otherwise, a license issued by the Board.~~

~~(2) “License” includes, unless the context requires otherwise, each of the following licenses:~~

~~(i) a license to practice cosmetology;~~

~~(ii) a license to manage a beauty salon;~~

~~(iii) a teacher license;~~

~~(iv) an assistant teacher license;~~

~~(v) a limited license to provide [demonstrating] MAKEUP ARTIST services;~~

~~(vi) a limited license to provide esthetic services;~~

~~(vii) a limited license to provide manicuring services;~~
