~~(a) To qualify for a limited license to practice cosmetology, an applicant shall be an individual who meets the requirements of this section.~~

~~(b) An applicant for a limited license to provide [demonstrating] MAKEUP ARTIST services shall [meet the training standards for each category of cosmetology to be demonstrated by the applicant]:~~

~~(1) BE AT LEAST 17 YEARS OLD;~~

~~(2) HAVE SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED A 9TH GRADE EDUCATION OR THE EQUIVALENT; AND~~

~~(3) HAVE SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED A COURSE OR PROGRAM IN MAKEUP ARTIST SERVICES APPROVED BY THE BOARD.~~
