- (ii) 1. have at least 2 years of experience as a licensed cosmetologist; and
- 2: have-completed successfully 2 courses in teaching in a program approved by the Board; or
- (iii) have completed successfully a degree program in cosmetology education at the University of Maryland or a similar institution approved by the Board.
- (D) IF THE APPLICANT IS LICENSED TO TEACH COSMETOLOGY IN ANOTHER STATE OR FOREIGN COUNTRY, THE APPLICANT MEETS THE TRAINING REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION IF THE APPLICANT HAS ACTIVELY TAUGHT COSMETOLOGY IN THE OTHER STATE OR FOREIGN COUNTRY FOR AT LEAST 6 MONTHS.
- {(d)} (E) Except as otherwise provided in this subtitle, an applicant for a license to teach cosmetology shall pass the appropriate examination given by the Board under this subtitle.

- (a) To qualify for a license to teach cosmetology limited to providing esthetic services[,] OR manicuring services, [or wig styling services,] the applicant shall be an individual who meets the requirements of this section.
- (b) An applicant for a license to teach cosmetology limited to providing esthetic services shall:
  - (1) be at least 18 years old;
  - (2) be a high school graduate or the equivalent;
  - (3) meet the training requirements that the Board sets, by regulation; and
  - (4) have been licensed for at least 2 years to provide esthetic services.
- (c) An applicant for a license to teach cosmetology-limited to providing manicuring services shall:
  - (1) be at least 18 years old;
  - (2) be a high-school graduate or the equivalent;
  - (3) meet the training requirements that the Board sets, by regulation; and
  - (4) have been licensed for at least 2 years to provide manieuring services.
- (d) [An applicant for a license to teach cosmetology limited to providing wig styling services shall:
  - (1) be at least 18 years old;
  - (2) be a high school-graduate or the equivalent;
