{(c) In addition to the other requirements of this section, an applicant for a cosmetologist aide license shall submit to the Board a certificate that is made under oath by an authorized physician and certifies that the applicant is free from any contagious or infectious disease that presents a hazard to a beauty salon patron.}

## <del>[5-311.] 5-310.</del>

- (a) An applicant who otherwise qualifies for a license is entitled to be examined as provided in this section.
- (b) (1) The Board may employ examiners to give examinations to applicants and designate an examiner to give the written or practical parts of the examination or both.
- (2) Subject to the State budget, each examiner is entitled to compensation of at least \$30 for each day on which the examiner is engaged in the duties of the employment.
- (e) The Board periodically shall give examinations to applicants at the times and places that the Board determines.
- (d) The Board shall give each qualified applicant notice of the time and place of examination.
- (e) (1) The Board shall determine the subjects, scope, and form of and the passing score for examinations given under this subtitle.
  - (2) An examination may consist of written and practical parts.
- (f) The Board shall mail to each applicant notice of the applicant's examination result.

## [5 312.] 5 311.

- (a) Subject to the provisions of this section, the Board shall waive any examination requirement of this subtitle for an individual who is licensed to practice [cosmetology]—AS—A—COSMETOLOGIST—OR—A—LIMITED—PRACTICE COSMETOLOGIST in another state.
  - (b) The Board may grant a waiver under this section only if the applicant:
    - (1) pays to the Board an application fee of \$25; and
    - (2) provides adequate evidence that the applicant:
      - (i) meets the qualifications otherwise required by this subtitle; and
- (ii) became licensed in the other state after meeting, in that or any other state, requirements that are at least equivalent to the licensing requirements of this State.
